### A Snapshot

- What:** The Census is a count of everyone residing in the U.S.
- Who:** All U.S. residents must be counted - people of all races and ethnic groups – **Citizens and Non-Citizens.**
- When:** Census Enumeration is **Now - July 2010.** Questionnaire responses should represent the household as it exists on form turn-in day.
- Why:**
- The Census will show state population and determine the number of U.S. Representatives.
  - The U.S. government allocates more than \$400 billion to communities based on the Census.
  - Census determines the plans for services that come to your community such as:
    - **Neighborhood Improvements**
    - **Public Health**
    - **Transportation**
    - **Emergency Preparedness**
    - **Education**
    - **Senior Services**
    - **Head Start**
